Wanted to make sure you are all aware that there are several more motels in the area which are not posted on the NCHA approval form. The Chatter has only so much space to deal with additional details. You all need to make your reservations well in advance because it is fishing season in Twin Bridges which means motels fill up quickly. Here are all of the options for rooms in the area.

- Ruby Valley Bed and Breakfast, Sheridan, 406 842-7111 (If you have a group, this is a great place to stay, it is an old Victorian house)

If you do not find suitable rooms at any of these places, give me a call and I will make sure I find you lodging. There are also some fishing cabins and homes which are rented on a weekend basis so let me know if you are in the market for a house or rental for the weekend and I will do my best to find something that fits.

We are going to have a burger feed on Friday night and kind of play it by ear on a Saturday function for dinner. We will have fresh cattle practice all day Friday and throughout the cutting. It will depend on how late the cutting runs if we try and plan a feed of some sort at the fairgrounds on Saturday. The Blue Anchor Bar is going to have some live music of some sort that evening so bring your dancing shoes, we may just have a feed at the bar after the cutting if it is late.

The Happy Trails Inn is connected to the Painted Horse Saloon in Sheridan if you are looking for lodging with a bar and restaurant. They also just completed a renovation of those facilities and the exterior is somewhat deceiving because it is very nice with renovated motel. The Old Hotel has excellent fine dining with quaint guest suites but bring your check book, not the cheapest place in town but I think worth the money. The Wagon Wheel restaurant is in the middle of town and not far from either Kings Motel or The Stonefly Inn which are on opposite ends of town. Both have cabins which cater to fisherman and have guide services if you want to partake in the fly fishing frenzy.

Sheridan and Twin Bridges are only 8 miles apart so either town will be convenient to the cutting.
