"SHOOT OUT" UPDATE

- "Shoot Out" held Sunday August 9th, 8:00 am, Majestic Valley Arena
- Top 3 \$ earners (points for jr/sr youth) in attendance, after the final two days of the series Aug 7 & 8th, will advance to the Shoot Out-This is a drop down system, so eligible spots will drop down to fill with those in attendance-the 50% +1 show rule will be waived if needed to fill 3 spots.
- Shoot Out classes include -Open, NP, 50 Amateur, 15 Novice, 15 NNP, 5 Novice, 5 NNP, 35 NP, 15 Amateur & 2000 LR. Jr & Sr Youth classes also included-Top 3 point earners in attendance
- Each class will have a \$1000 jackpot (except Jr/Sr. Youth)-Shoot Out is "winner takes all"-paying 1 spot. Youth riders will be riding for Jim Reno bronzes. All Shoot Out contestants will receive a finalist vest.
- Shoot Out contestants will have a cattle charge of \$150, except youth. If sponsorship is not found for the youth cattle, they will cut reruns.
- Shoot Out show costs will be covered by the NW Regional Cutting Series, except cattle. All fees and winnings will be collected and awarded through the NW Regional Cutting Series and Becky Sleeman.
- At the conclusion of the show August 8th, finalists will be determined and 3 sets of 12 will be drawn. All contestants, all classes, will be drawn together as one 36 rider class, therefore working order will be as drawn, and will not fall in a class order.
- Shoot Out will be judged by one judge/Todd Adolf.
- The Shoot Out is a NW Regional Cutting Series final event and any money earned during the Sunday shootout **does not** count on NCHA horse/rider earning eligibility or Eastern/Western Nationals or world standings.
- The above 2015 Shoot Out rules/format were finalized 7/23/2015 by the 2015 NW Regional Cutting Series Committee, consisting of Keith McGinnis WA, Jamie Pedersen OR, Russ & Julie Elrod OR, Denise Shewmaker ID, Scott Martin ID, Kathy Foote MT, Jann Parker MT and Theresa Nelson MT within the guidelines of the NW Regional Cutting Series info outlined earlier this year.
