### 2016 BIG SKY FUTURITY & AGED EVENT Rules & Regulations

- 1. Futurity: Open and Non pro divisions. This division will have 2 go rounds and a finals. All entries, excluding zero scores, will advance to the second go. Futurity~30% back to finals.
- Derby: Open and Non Pro divisions. This division will have 2 go rounds and a finals. 70% back to 2<sup>nd</sup> go, 25% back to finals.
- **3.** Classic/Challenge: Open and Non Pro. This division will have 2 go rounds and a finals. 70% back to 2<sup>nd</sup> go, 20% back to finals.
- Pro-Am: Open and Non Pro. Any age horse is eligible. This division will have 2 go rounds and a finals.
   Pro riders 1<sup>st</sup> go. Amateur/NP riders 2<sup>nd</sup> go. Rider with highest score will show in finals.
- 5. Bridleless: Any age horse is eligible. Any rider. No payouts: Awards trophy to winner.
- 6. All payments are final. Refunds will be made only upon approval by show management. Show management reserves the right to cancel any event or classes within an event, without prior notice to the contest, without liability to show management. In such an event, fees pertaining to that class will be refunded.
- 7. The two judge system with NCHA Self-Adjusted Monitor System will be used.
- 8. Payout: Total purse will be paid in the finals, with all finalists receiving their entry fee in premium. The top 50% of finalists will receive additional premiums.
- 9. Any class with less than 8 entries (excluding the Pro/Am) will have a non-working final, with all monies paid based on the cumulative scores of the go-rounds of the class. An advancement fee will be assessed to those advancing to the finals.
- 10. Entry Deadline: Entries are due by August 1st. Online entries accepted with payment in the form of credit card or check required. Canadian checks will not be accepted, US funds only. Payment must be received before entries will be put in the draw. <u>No Exceptions.</u> Credit card payments will have a 3% processing fee added. All fees shall be made payable to Big Sky Aged Event. All earnings will be withheld until tax ID or SSN #'s are and current contact information is supplied to the show office and all charges are verified as paid.
- 11. There is no limit to the number of horses a rider may ride in any division.
- 12. All contestants must be in good standing with NCHA and all NCHA rules will be followed and apply when not in direct conflict with BSAE rules. All rules are subject to change by action of the Big Sky Futurity & Aged Event.
- 13. BIG SKY FUTURITY COMMITTEE, the producer of this event, reserves the right to accept or reject any entry or substitution and to disqualify any contestant for any action of misconduct. All decisions of the BSAE are final. It is hereby understood by all participants when making entry you have released the BSAE of any liability for accidents or injury which may occur during the event to entrants, their employees or property.
- 14. The BSAE reserves the right to cancel the event or a class without notice any time prior to start of the event or class without liability to them, but in such case, shall return all fees paid by contestants. BSAE reserves the right to make any changes, additions and deletions to these rules as deemed necessary by them for the betterment of the show as they do not contradict NCHA rules. Notice of any changes will be posted.
